SCHOLARSHIP AWARD APPLICATION
CHAPTER PROFESSIONAL ADVANCEMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

The Missouri Chapter of the APWA is an association of professional engineers, technicians, operations staff, public works directors, business people, contractors, consultants, and others who join together to exchange ideas and information, promote education and training, and work as a team to meet professional and community needs. The Missouri Chapter's membership comes from the geographic area of the state of Missouri outside the Kansas City Metropolitan area.

The Missouri Chapter Professional Advancement Scholarship is a reimbursement of up to \$500 awarded to a current APWA Missouri Chapter member in good standing whom participates in the APWA National's Donald C. Stone Foundation or Emerging Leaders Academy program. Reimbursable expenses include: registration fees, lodging and travel costs (airfare, rental car, and/or mileage at the current IRS rate).

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:

- Register and participate in the APWA National's Donald C. Stone Foundation or Emerging Leaders Academy.
- Be a member in good standing of the Missouri Chapter with the exception that current members of the Awards and Historical Committee are ineligible.
- Have not previously been awarded the Professional Advancement Award.

Application Procedures:

Submit the following:

1. Completed APWA Scholarship Application
2. Copy of Registration in the APWA National's Donald C. Stone Foundation or Emerging Leaders Academy.

Applications must be received no later than April 1 at 12:00 midnight. Scholarship winners will be notified no later than May 30. Award winners will be recognized at an APWA luncheon in St. Louis, typically held in June. Attendance at the luncheon is encouraged but not required.
